The first step in adding a ringtone to your phone is finding one that you like. Generally, this means checking out one of the dozens of ringtones, to cover song royalties, among other things, and some sites provide tones for free. A lot of older songs (such as classical pieces) have been around long enough that their copyright has expired -- they've entered the public domain, so they're free for anybody to use. Once you've found a ringtone you like, you just have to get it into your phone's memory. There are a number of different ways to do this, depending on your particular phone model. The three major ways to add a new ringtone are:Load the ringtone program into the phone from a computer, via a data cable.Send the program to the phone over the airwaves.Type the program into the phones have multiple options. Step 5: Copy the file and delete the old one Once created, click the AAC version of your song and drag it to the desktop or your desired save location. This will copy the file to that location.
